

Merwyn A. Haney Memorial Prize

Guidelines & Renewal

The Merwyn A. Haney Memorial Prize was established by the Board of Education and endowed by Ishpeming High School Alumnus Roxie Smail Walker. The Prize was created in memory of former Ishpeming High School chemistry teacher Merwyn A. Haney. Members of the graduating class at Ishpeming High School are eligible to apply for the M.A. Haney Memorial Prize if they meet the following:

- 1. A completed application must be submitted to the Guidance Office no later than March 31st.**
2. The applicant must have a minimum of a 3.00 grade point average upon completion of seven (7) semesters of high school study.
3. The applicant must have completed at least 5 of the current Science courses offered at Ishpeming High School, although candidates who have completed all 6 courses will be preferred.. At present, this includes Physical Science, Biology, Chemistry, Advanced Chemistry, Advanced Biology and Physics. In the case of a transfer student, their academic record will be evaluated to determine eligibility.
4. The applicant must have completed (be enrolled in) Functions, Statistics and Trigonometry (FST) and/or Pre-Calculus.
5. The applicant must be considered outstanding in one field of science.
6. The applicant must have demonstrated effort, commitment and interest in science during his/her high school studies.
7. The applicant must demonstrate that he/she has been accepted in a science related field at the baccalaureate level at a college or university.
8. The applicant must demonstrate financial need.
- 9. *The M.A. Haney Memorial Prize shall be renewable on an annual basis for an additional three years, provided that:***
 - A. A completed renewal application is submitted by May 1st, accompanied by a transcript of completed college/university course work.
 - B. The recipient has maintained a minimum of a 3.00 grade point average in a college/university baccalaureate level science related field
